To Whom It May Concern:

HDR has been retained by the City of Brampton to undertake a study for a Light Rail Transit (LRT) Extension from the Gateway Terminal (at Hurontario Street and Steeles Avenue) to the Brampton GO Station within the City of Brampton. The study corridors are identified in the attached map.

The Study involves evaluating alternative LRT routes along two corridors – Kennedy Road and McLaughlin Road and any sub-options, including alternative alignments, underground or elevated sections, road widening, shared running, and one-way or two-way loops. The Study will complete all necessary related studies and preliminary design with input from the public and potentially affected parties prior to initiating the Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP).

An introductory open house is being held to provide information about how the study is being undertaken. You will have the opportunity to provide input on the preliminary alternatives and share ideas with the project team. Information about how this project relates to ongoing City initiatives will also be available. The notice of commencement and introductory open house is attached for your reference.
