Proposal

This Zoning By-law amendment application is to permit a 4-storey, stacked townhouse development with commercial uses on the ground floor. The proposal includes 104 residential units having a gross floor area of 9 233 square metres (99,383 square feet) and 776 square metres (8,353 square feet) of commercial space on the ground floor. This application is for three properties (3310, 3312 and 3314 Kingston Road) that occupy the northwest corner of Kingston Road and Mason Road. The current zoning for these properties does not permit residential uses.
